Introducing our new guest artist

I'm a full time artist working from my studio a stone's throw from Hannafore beach in Looe. I'm best described as a mixed media artist as I very rarely use just one medium in my work. My artworks generally contain a variety of media; hand-painted collage, old maps and book pages, paint , pastels and pencil. I am probably best known for my map paintings, celebrating endangered and extinct wildlife, I've even had one exhibited at the Royal Academy.

My painting 'Swimming Against The Tide' was a finalist in *Portraits From The Edge*, sponsored by Octopus Energy and exhibited at the Royal Academy in February 2020.

My work lately tends to be semi-abstract, and inspired by coastal life and its colours, textures, flora and fauna. My 'Kilminorth Kingfisher' is an example. Kilminorth Woods just outside Looe is an ancient woodland, teeming with wildlife including kingfishers. A tranquil and beautiful place.

These multi-layered complex pieces are colourful and textural, a nod to my roots in textile design. They are fun to look at but often contain a deeper meaning. My thoughts are never far from the challenges that our wildlife faces, from climate change and human interference plus the additional threats from illnesses such as avian flu.

As well as exhibiting in Polperro I have also exhibited in London during 2022 in two

prestigious exhibitions: The Royal Watercolour Society's *Open Exhibition* in the Bankside Gallery where I won The Dry Red Press Prize with my painting, 'Oystercatchers' and at The Mall Galleries in October 2022 where I was thrilled to have my work, 'Sounding The Alarm' chosen for The Society of Wildlife Artists' *Natural Eye* exhibition. This is an art exhibition I visit every year as I am originally from London, and it was an honour and a privilege to see my work hanging alongside artists that I respect and admire so greatly.
